

WE ARE IN A **FEROCIOUS** SPIRITUAL BATTLE WITH A **DEADLY ENEMY**





HOW SATAN WAGES WAR

1: THE ROARING LION

Some Jews who went around driving out evil spirits tried to invoke the name of the Lord Jesus over those who were demonpossessed. They would say, "In the name of Jesus, whom Paul preaches, I command you to come out." 14 Seven sons of Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, were doing this. 15 One day the evil spirit answered them, "Jesus I know, and I know about Paul, but who are you?" 16 Then the man who had the evil spirit jumped on them and overpowered them all. He gave them such a beating that they ran out of the house naked and bleeding (Acts 19:13-16)

2: THE TAME LION

When this became known to the Jews and Greeks living in Ephesus, they were all seized with fear, and the name of the Lord Jesus was held in high honour. 18 Many of those who believed now came and openly confessed their evil deeds. 19 A number who had practised sorcery brought their scrolls together and burned them publicly. When they calculated the value of the scrolls, the total came to fifty thousand drachmas. (Act 19:17-19)

3: AN ANGEL OF LIGHT

This fellow Paul has convinced and led astray large numbers of people here in Ephesus and in practically the whole province of Asia. He says that man-made gods are no gods at all. ²⁷ There is danger... . that the temple of the great goddess Artemis will be discredited, and the goddess herself, who is worshipped throughout the province of Asia and the world, will be robbed of her divine majesty." 28 When they heard this, they were furious and began shouting: "Great is Artemis of the Ephesians!" 29 Soon the whole city was in an uproar. (Act 19:24-29)


4: THE PUPPET MASTER

The puppet master

A silversmith named Demetrius, who made silver shrines of Artemis, brought in no little business for the craftsmen. ²⁵ He called them together, along with the workmen in related trades, and said: "Men, you know we receive a good income from this business. ²⁶ And you see and hear how this fellow Paul has convinced and led astray large numbers of people here in Ephesus and in practically the whole province of Asia . . . ²⁷ There is danger not only that our trade will lose its good name, but also that the temple of the great goddess Artemis will be discredited." (Act 19:24-27)



HOW GOD WAGES WAR

1: THROUGH HIS SON

¹³ Some Jews who went around driving out evil spirits tried to invoke the name of the Lord Jesus over those who were demon-possessed. They would say, "In the name of Jesus, whom Paul preaches, I command you to come out. " 14 Seven sons of Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, were doing this. ¹⁵ One day the evil spirit answered them, "Jesus I know, and I know about Paul, but who are you?" (Act 19:13-15)

2: THROUGH HIS SPIRIT

"Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" They answered, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit. " 3 So Paul asked, "Then what baptism did you receive?" "John's baptism," they replied. 4 Paul said, "John's baptism was a baptism of repentance. He told the people to believe in the one coming after him, that is, in Jesus." ⁵ On hearing this, they were baptised into the name of the Lord Jesus. 6 When Paul placed his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they spoke in tongues and prophesied. (Act 19:1-6)



LET'S STAY WITH THIS

IN THE OLD TESTAMENT THIS IS THE **BIG THING** THE MESSIAH WILL DO

And afterwards, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions. Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days. (Joel 2.28ff)

IN THE NEW **TESTAMENT THIS** IS THE **BIG THING JESUS DOES**

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. (Act 2:1-4)

IN THE NEW TESTAMENT **THIS** IS THE **BIG THING JESUS DOES**

this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel: "In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. 
THE HOLY SPIRIT IS THE BLESSING GOD **PROMISED** TO ABRAHAM He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit. (Galatians 3:14)

THE GREAT WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IS TO **GLORIFY JESUS**

I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. He will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you. (Joh 16:12-14)



Many nominal Christians realize they are not converted and cross over in to living faith . . .







HOW AWAKE ARE YOU?


How real has God been to your heart this week?

How clear and vivid is your assurance and certainty of God's forgiveness and fatherly love? To what degree is that real to you right now?




Are you having any particular seasons of delight in God?

Do you really sense his presence in your life, sense him giving you his love?




Have you been finding Scripture to be alive and active?

Instead of just being a book, do you feel like Scripture is coming after you?




Are you finding certain biblical promises extremely precious and encouraging?

Which ones?




Are you finding God is challenging you or calling you to something through the Word?

In what ways?




Are you finding God's grace more glorious and moving now than you have in the past?
